Safe Haven Enterprise Visa – Western Australia

The Safe Haven Enterprise Visa (SHEV) (subclass 790) allows eligible Illegal Maritime Arrivals to remain in Australia for five years. A benefit of this visa is that if you meet the [SHEV pathway requirements](#), you may be eligible to apply for a prescribed substantive onshore visa (but not a permanent protection visa) at a later date. One of the pathway requirements is that you work without accessing special benefit payments and/or study full time in a nominated regional area of Australia.

Regional areas

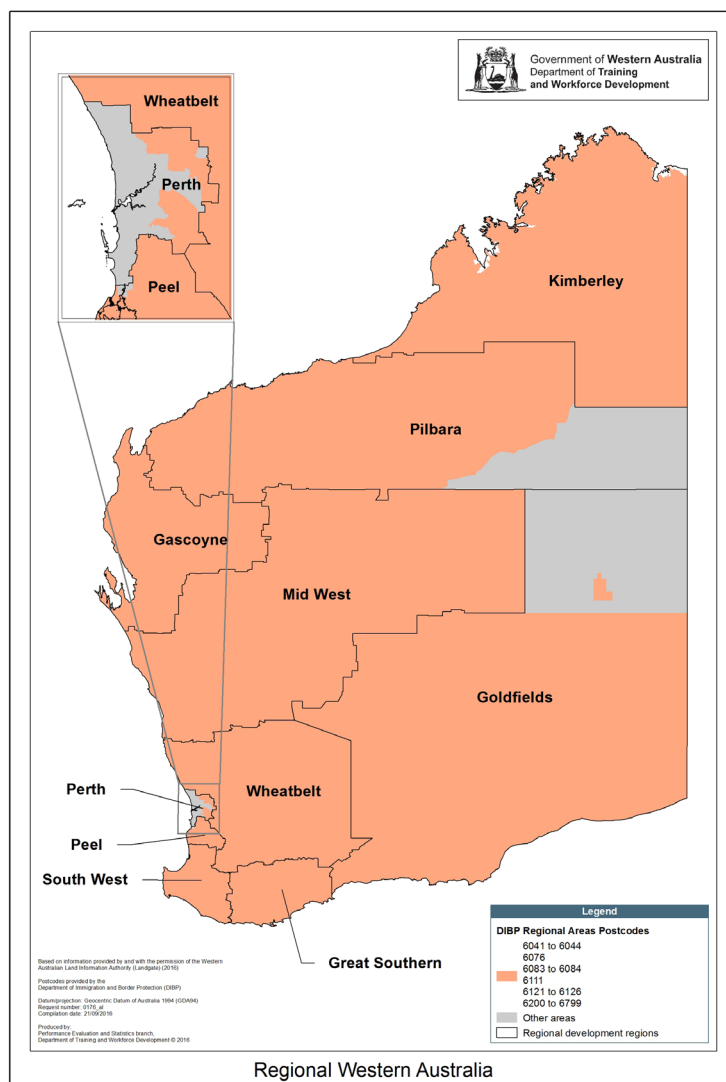
For Western Australia, the nominated regional areas cover the following postcodes:

- 6041 to 6044;
- 6076;
- 6083 to 6084;
- 6111;
- 6121 to 6126; and
- 6200 to 6799.

Perth and surrounding areas are excluded in addition to certain very remote areas in the Pilbara and Goldfields–Esperance regions.
