

MIGRATION PATHWAYS TO WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Migration in Australia is made up of three streams: humanitarian, family and skilled. The stream suitable for you depends on many factors including your age, occupation and employment status.

To find out if you are eligible to apply for an Australian visa under one of these streams, visit the Department of Home Affairs (Home Affairs) Visa Finder at immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas/getting-a-visa/visa-finder 🕞



MIGRATION ADVICE

If you would like to appoint someone to provide immigration assistance, they must be either:

- ▷ a registered migration agent;
- ▷ a legal practitioner; or
- ▷ an exempt person.

SKILLED MIGRANT EMPLOYMENT REGISTER

Western Australia's strong economic growth and low unemployment rates has increased the need for skilled workers across many sectors in the State.

The Skilled Migrant Employment Register is a free initiative supporting employers and skilled migrants to connect and build the WA workforce.

STATE NOMINATED MIGRATION PROGRAM

Migration Services delivers the State nominated migration program on behalf of the WA State Government. Eligible applicants can receive State nomination for two visa subclasses (gaining extra points on the Department of Home Affairs points test):

- ▷ Skilled nominated visa (subclass 190) receiving an extra five points; or
- ▷ Skilled work regional (provisional) visa (subclass 491) receiving an extra 15 points.

CERTIFICATION FOR REGIONAL VISAS

Migration Services are an approved Department of Home Affairs Regional Certifying Body, providing certification for regional visas for WA, except the Goldfields–Esperance region.

This program allows employers in regional Australia to sponsor (nominate) skilled migrants to fill employment vacancies, where the employer cannot source an appropriately skilled Australian worker.

SETTLEMENT SERVICES

Settlement Services is a free information and referral service, assisting migrants to establish their life in WA, ensuring a successful settlement journey.

WESTERN AUSTRALIA'S BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY IS THRIVING!

Strong economic growth and low unemployment rates are making skilled workforce needs a priority for the State Government.

CONSTRUCTION VISA SUBSIDY PROGRAM

The Western Australian Government has invested \$11 million in the Construction Visa Subsidy Program (CVSP) to support skilled migration visa pathways to fill in-demand construction occupations.

The CVSP will provide grant payments of up to \$10,000 per skilled migrant, offsetting costs such as migration agent fees, visa application fees and relocation expenses.
